Stay with us while you enjoy our many activities. We have shaded sites with free laundry, showers and toilets. \$10 - no hookups, \$18 - full service.

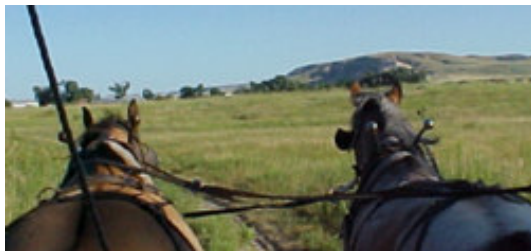
